Abstract

Following a brief overview of religion(s) on the ground in the Kingdom of Denmark, in the past but especially at present, the lecture will pay special attention to

- 1) ways in which the Danish state today handles religion(s), and freedom of religion,
- 2) dominant notions of religion- including notions of a proper place for religion in the state and in society at large - religion and politics, and religion and Danish culture,
- 3) religion as it is handled by the state in the shape of education about religion in public and private schools.

The lecture will be accompanied by a series of images illustrative of the points made.
